Heating Elements

DANGER:

- These heating elements are not insulated. Contacting an energized heating element can cause burns, electrocution, or death. Always turn off the power to the unit when there is any chance of contacting the exposed element.
- Equipment using these elements should be operated on circuits protected by a ground fault interrupter (G.F.I.).
- All circuitry and equipment should be checked prior to use by a licensed electrician.
- Check with Federal, State and Local building and wiring codes prior to use.

OPERATING:

- A single element needs to operate on a circuit capable of providing 110 VAC at 15 amps.
- Two elements will require 220 VAC at 15 amps. The two elements should be wired in series when connected to 220 Vac.
